Andrew Hadley has extensive experience of strategic development, design, management and evaluation of international education and cultural projects, especially those involving young people. He specialises in the development of youth networks and management of intercultural youth events.

Andrew previously worked for the British Council, and has lived in Turkey, Ethiopia, Greece, China and most recently Macedonia, where, as the British Council's Director, he devised and developed the acclaimed *Blue Sky* youth network. He has designed and directed numerous large-scale youth events, and led a wide range of other youth projects in S.E. Europe, Ethiopia and the UK. In 2005 he co-directed the European Youth Partnership Project (a 24-country youth exchange), and in 2007 he directed the British Council's *Youth, Sport, Action!* project, involving over 200 young people from the UK and 10 other countries. Andrew has recently been presented with an award by the Royal Society of Arts and T-Mobile for a project to increase positive interaction between young people and adults in the community.

Andrew was educated at Christ Church, Oxford where he read Classics. His interests include languages, music, film and architecture. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts. In 2005 he was awarded the MBE for his international work with young people. He is married with three children, and lives in Clapham, London.
