The Event

This time we are putting it quite literally centre stage. The stage is a live TV studio environment where everyone gets the chance to be behind and in front of the cameras.

The Date

Afternoon Wednesday 21 March through to lunchtime Friday 23 March.

The Place

Victoria Hotel - Sheffield: four star accommodation, good food and a comfortable environment for creative discussion and learning.

The People

60 professionals and young people from across the UK, all with ideas and experience to share about inclusion and how to advance this through international projects.

The Team

The TV studio will be run by young people from mainstream and special education, supported by Momentum's experienced trainers and facilitators.

The Approach

This event is all about inclusion in practice. You will hear and see inspiring examples of inclusive projects around the UK and overseas. But the event will also offer first hand experience of an inclusive project where everyone has a role and is valued for what they can do.

The Deal

Thanks to support from the European Commission and the British Council, we are able to offer a participation fee of only £100 per person. If you bring a young person with you (age 16+) there are bursaries available to help reduce their fees even further. In addition we will reimburse travel expenses up to £65 per person. **Please note** anyone bringing young people under 18 is responsible for addressing any safeguarding procedures.

To bring together people with Youth in Action project experience who want to share best practice about inclusion, and specialists in inclusion who want to explore international youth projects. To encourage fresh thinking. To create new professional partnerships. To provide a development opportunity for young people.
